
The great benefit gap – do you claim enough?

## **Description**



One in five pensioners isn't claiming the benefits to which they're entitled. And each year, up to £2.2 billion of benefits goes unclaimed by older people.

Those statistics have been shared recently by support groups <u>Independent Age</u> and <u>Age UK</u>. Both organisations are encouraging older people to check their benefits status.

Many people miss out on extra money they could be getting

'A lot of people miss out on extra money they could be getting,' said Independent Age. 'It's well worth checking whether you might be entitled to more than you currently claim.'

Independent Age have published an <u>advice and resources centre</u> on their website. The page offers guidance on a number of benefits from Attendance Allowance to Pension Credit – with a Benefit Checker to help people find out exactly what they can claim.

In addition, <u>a free guide called *Moneywise*</u> tells readers how to boost their income and save money. Copies can be ordered free of charge, downloaded as a PDF, or even played online as audio files.

For further guidance, enquirers are invited to call Independent Age's freephone helpline on 0800 319 6789. The organisation said they will aim to provide advice or support directly, or point the person in the right direction.

Age UK also offer <u>an information and advice page</u> on their website. Their list covers a whole range of benefits from Carer's Allowance to Cold Weather Payment.
